Drug Repositioning and Innovative Delivery

This special issue aims to shed some light on the future of pharmacy development in two aspects, drug repositioning and innovative delivery methods.

Drug repositioning (DR), also known as drug reprofiling, drug repurposing or drug reusing, has been a trending field of research since 2004, which attracts the attention of researchers from medicine, pharmacy, biochemistry and other related fields. Drug repositioning is a process of discovering novel uses and therapeutic applications of existing drugs. Take methotrexate (MTX) for example. MTX was initially discovered as chemotherapy to treat cancer, and later it is found that low doses of methotrexate has an anti-inflammatory effect and is used widely for rheumatoid arthritis (RA) and skin symptoms such as eczema and psoriasis. Various methods have been developed in conventional fields, whereas with the advancement of big data and machine learning, DR becomes even more cost-effective and accurate. This special issue looks for the recent development of DR in silico, in vitro and/or in vivo

Each year there are millions of new drugs/medicine developed, new mechanisms of drug delivery are also created and evolved. Typical delivery methods are oral administration, topical treatment, injection and infusion. This special issue also collects interesting problems worth investigation for these methods, e.g., delivery vehicle designs and controlled release methods. Innovative methods of drug delivery techniques, e.g., low-frequency sonophoresis, are also of the scope of this special issue.
